This seminar course will focus on the use of genetic relatedness techniques in studying population and social structure of marine organisms. We will examine methods of data collection and analysis by exploring the methodological literature as well as several case studies. Students will be given an opportunity to discuss how relatedness can be used in their thesis research and explore the methods that would be used to answer the questions they are interested in.

The course will be held at the SWFSC building, and students will need a valid driver's license to enter the building. Non-US citizens should contact Phillip Morin at least 2 weeks prior to the start of the course, as there are special permissions needed to enter a government building.
