Dolphin Acoustics Internship

An internship is currently available in the Dolphin Cognition Lab, UCSD, for an undergraduate student with experience in collecting acoustic recordings. The position involves recording vocalizations during experiments conducted with Bottlenose Dolphins at the US Navy Marine Mammal facility in Point Loma, San Diego. As a result, the internship is restricted to US citizens only. The intern would be responsible for deploying the acoustic recording equipment during research sessions, and assuring that all recordings are catalogued and saved for further analysis. Participation in those analyses may also be involved. Research is conducted on Fridays, Saturdays, Sundays and Mondays, from 09:30 until 13:30, year round. The current internship would, ideally, extend from Spring 2020, through summer, and include Fall 2020 as well, for which the student would receive 4 units of Independent Study (or equivalent) credit, per term (including for summer sessions). SIO credit may also be available for part or all of this internship.

The **deadline** for applicants for Spring is **March 1, 2020**.
