

**SIO 262 – Spring 2019**  
**Seminars and Forum in Marine Chemical Biology and Natural Products**  
**2 units**

This quarter will continue a program of research talks in marine chemical biology (approx. 45 min). These talks are given by graduate students (usually PhD students but MS students are also welcome to participate) and generally describe some aspect of their thesis research. In some cases, students may elect to give a more formal lecture in a subject area of relevance to their research interests. There will be one speaker and one moderator each week. Speakers will send out an approx. 250 word abstract **the Monday prior to their talk**. Speakers will also provide the moderator with a CV and other relevant information needed for an effective introduction. Moderators will provide an in-depth introduction, control all aspects of the seminar, and oversee a question and answer session immediately following the talk. Following this Q+A session, which includes faculty, post-docs, and others interested in the field, the students enrolled in the course will meet privately with the speaker for the remainder of the class period. The goal of this more informal session is for students to provide feedback to the speaker on the quality of the talk and to dive more deeply into topics that may not be familiar to all students. Grading will be based on the quality of the presentations, moderating activities, participation, and attendance.
