As summer approaches keep in mind [UC San Diego Laboratory Safety Policies](#) still apply!

- [Personal Protective Equipment \(PPE\)](#) minimum requirements for lab workers include covered legs and closed-toed shoes at all times.
 - Additional appropriate PPE must also be worn when hazardous materials or equipment is used.



Minimum lab attire for all lab workers in UC research facilities:

- clothing that covers the legs
- closed toe/heel shoes

Free PPE for UCSD Researchers

UC San Diego has a centrally funded PPE Distribution Program to provide research staff with minimum personal protective equipment (PPE).

- Each eligible lab member can receive 2 lab coats and 2 pairs of safety glasses. Labs can also receive face shields and chemical splash goggles.

You're eligible if you're assigned to a UCSD research lab and will remain with the lab for at least 6 months.

To participate, search "PPE Support for Researchers" on Blink, then download and complete the *Embroidered Lab Coat Fitting* form.

Bring your signed form to UCtr 401, room 107, to select and be fitted for PPE. Open Monday – Friday, 10 a.m. – 3p.m.

- [Minors in Labs](#): No one under the age of 14 is allowed in UC San Diego/SIO laboratories, shops, or vivaria other than as part of an approved and supervised tour.
 - Any tour that views an experiment/demonstration needs prior approval by EH&S.
 - Active use of hazardous chemicals or processes are not permitted during tours.
 - **This policy also applies to staff family members and friends.**
